









Key Signatures Part 2

The mnemonic for remembering the order that flats appear in key signatures is exactly the opposite of the one we used for sharps. It goes like this:



Battle		Key of F
Ends		Key of Bb
And		Key of Eb
Down		Key of Ab
Goes		Key of Db
Charles		Key of Gb
Father		Key of Cb

- In order to figure out what key signature a piece of music is in if it contains flats, look to the 2nd to last flat, and that's your key signature.
- Remember that you do have remember the key of F has only a Bb.
